


Installer Wireshark Linux

sudo dpkg-reconfigure wireshark-common
```

Dumpcap can be installed in a way that allows members of the "wireshark"
system group to capture packets. This is recommended over the

sudo chmod +x /usr/bin/dumpcap
```

sudo adduser $USER wireshark
```
